CUMBERLAND COUNTY GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY'S SCHOLARSHIP FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES

PURPOSE: To provide a scholarship to one (1) deserving Cumberland County, NS high school graduates interested in or intending to pursue a Maritime or Acadian history course of study in a Maritime university.

AWARD COMPONENTS: One (1) \$2000 [Two thousand dollar] scholarship and individual certificate awarded to one (1) student selected by the Cumberland County Genealogical Society's Scholarship Committee.

CRITERIA:

- 1. Applicant must be a Cumberland County, Nova Scotia resident.
- 2. Applicant must be graduating high school in the year of the award.
- 3. Applicant must be a full-time Maritime university student in the coming academic year with an interest or intent to pursue a Maritime or Acadian history course of study in an accredited Maritime university.
- 4. Applicant must demonstrate scholarship -- in the complete sense -- consistent with capacity and circumstances.

APPLICATION PROCESS: (APPLICANT MUST SUBMIT)

- 1. Completed application form (handwritten and/or incomplete applications will not be processed).
- 2. Letter of application addressed to the Scholarship Committee. The letter should contain a brief explanation of career goals and biographical (background) information.
- 3. One (1) letter of recommendation from the student's high school teacher, guidance counselor administrator, or former employer.
- 4. A complete high school transcript with cumulative grade point averages and a class standing/rank.
- 5. A minimum 500 word essay on one of the following three topics:
 - a) History of your Cumberland County, Nova Scotia community
 - b) Biographical sketch of your family's ancestry in Cumberland County, Nova Scotia
 - c) Timeline of historical events from 1760-1800 in Cumberland County, Nova Scotia

Deadline for application is May 31, 2025. Applications postmarked after this date will not be considered.
